General Information

Overseas Tours By Union Representative Teams And Club Teams

Unions' Representative Teams

1. Each application for a tour overseas by a Unions' Representative team or by a Union to receive a tour by an overseas Representative team should be considered on its merits; nevertheless a Union will be expected to fulfill its normal obligations to other Unions.

Club Tours

2. The requirements relating to Club tours apply to all Grades and to tours either to or from New Zealand.
3. School teams may go on tour during the school holidays as part of their school's activities.
4. Except for school teams, Clubs, wishing to travel overseas to play matches may be absent from NZ only between the second Saturday in September and the first Friday in April the following year, but Provincial Unions may recommend a dispensation in very special circumstances.
5. Unless there are very special circumstances the period of absence from NZ must not exceed three weeks and the itinerary must comprise not less than two matches.
6. A Club team required for a normal Union competition will not be given permission to travel overseas when so required.
7. Members of a Club touring party must be bona fide financial members of that Club.
8. Any player required for a Union representative team may not be permitted to travel overseas with a Club team.
9. The management of a touring team must be approved by the Union to which the Club is affiliated.
10. A Club wishing to travel overseas must advise its Union of its intention to do so not less than three months before the proposed date of departure.
11. Appeals other than to Club members, for donations to assist with financing a tour must not be circulated beyond the boundaries of the Union to which the Club is affiliated.
12. Any Club proposing to tour overseas must, in the first instance, make application to its Union for permission to do so in the prescribed form. The required information includes:
 - (a) The inclusive dates of the tour.
 - (b) The number of players in the team, the number and the names of the Officials, and the status of the team (i.e. the Grade in which it plays).
 - (c) The number of matches to be played, the Clubs who will play against the visiting team and the dates on which the matches will be played.
 - (d) Any proposed financial arrangements with the Clubs to be visited or other organisations.
 - (e) The total cost of the tour and the total amount in hand at the date of the application.
 - (f) Details of insurance against injury or illness of team members while overseas.
13. The host Club overseas must have obtained the permission of its national Rugby Union. It is essential that the national Rugby Union advise the NZRU that it has given permission for the tour.
14. A Club inviting an overseas Club to play matches in NZ must inform their local Union immediately of any such negotiations. Similarly they must advise details of any approach made to them to play an overseas team on tour in NZ.
15. In special circumstances and upon conditions acceptable to the provincial Unions concerned the NZRU may permit teams from the Northern Hemisphere only to make a limited tour of NZ at any time.
16. A Union, when forwarding to NZRU an application by a Club to tour overseas, must state whether or not it considers approval should be granted. It is essential that the Union:
 - (a) Is satisfied with the Clubs' general financial position and that the funds stated to be held are in hand.
 - (b) Certifies that the host Club overseas has obtained the permission of its national Rugby Union.
 - (c) Certifies that all members of the touring party are bona fide financial members of that Club.
17. It is recommended to Unions that they encourage Clubs to tour within NZ rather than overseas.

Metropolitan Trophies

SPEIGHT'S CHALLENGE SHIELD

Rules

1. The Speight's Challenge Shield shall be played for in the round-robin section of the Premier Division 1 competition.
2. All "home" games in which the holders compete during the round-robin are deemed challengers
3. The holders of the shield shall be responsible for having the shield on display at the game venue.
4. If the team challenging for the shield wins the game it shall be presented with the shield at the end of game and become the new holders.
5. The challengers must win the game to hold the shield. If the game ends in a draw, the usual game format applied (i.e. no extra time is played) and the team holding the shield at the beginning of the game retains it.
6. If the shield holder defaults a game, the challenging team becomes the new shield holder.
7. If the game is called off or cancelled by the Match Committee, the holder retains the shield.
8. Any team that wins the Speight's Challenge Shield during the season and its club, shall receive special reward and recognition from the sponsor, Speight's Brewery. The reward and recognition is to be determined by the sponsor and will fall due at the end of the holders 'reign', during the competition.
9. The team holding the shield at the completion of the round(s)-robin competition shall become "The Season Holder" of the Speight's Challenge Shield and shall start the round-robin competition the following year as holder.
10. The season holder shall receive special reward and recognition from the sponsor Speight's Brewery. The reward and recognition is to be determined by the sponsor and will fall due at the end of the round(s)-robin competition.
11. Other or exceptional situations will be addressed by the Match Committee if and when they arise.

AINGE SHIELD

Rules

1. The Ainge Shield competition shall be open to all Metropolitan Senior and Junior clubs, except Secondary/Primary Schools and University Social grades.
2. The minimum number of teams entered by any one club shall be five.
3. The Ainge Shield shall be awarded to the club with the lowest number of points according to the following formula. If a team finishes first in the competition, one point shall be awarded, if a team finishes second in the competition two points shall be awarded and so on. ie an extra point will be awarded for each position down the competition the team finishes.

Regulations For Metropolitan Club Rugby

1. Control

- (a) All matches including non-competition games shall be under the control of the Otago Rugby Football Union (ORFU) and all entries shall be subject to its approval. The Metropolitan Rugby Council shall classify the various clubs, teams and players, arrange dates, times and venues for matches in the various grades, and deal with all questions arising out of the same.
- (b) Notwithstanding anything else contained within these rules, the ORFU shall retain the right to amend any competition rules, should the circumstances so dictate.

2. Laws of the Game

All games shall be played under the Laws of the Game of Rugby Football and in accordance with the New Zealand Rugby football Union (NZRU) Domestic Safety Variations. For the purpose of the Application of the Domestic Safety Variations Premier Divisions 1 and 2 shall be classified as "Senior Club A".

3. Team Entries

All clubs and schools must supply the Metropolitan Rugby Council with team entries for their club for all grades as follows:

- (a) In respect of Premier grades three weeks prior to the first scheduled competition game in that grade.
- (b) In respect of all other grades two weeks prior to the first scheduled competition game in that grade.
- (c) Entries received after this date will be allowed only at the discretion of the Metropolitan Rugby Council.

4. Player Transfers

- (a) If a player is registered to a club and moves to another club within the same Provincial Union, either in the same rugby season or between rugby seasons, that player must comply with the club transfer policy in that Provincial Union.
- (b) All players wishing to transfer to another club must obtain a written clearance from the club which they last played for in the previous 12 months. That clearance must state that the former club has consented to the transfer, that the player is not subject to any suspension or playing ban and that the transferring player is not in arrears with his or her subscription.
- (c) Notwithstanding Rule 4(b) above, a player who has not played rugby in the previous 12 months shall not be required to provide a clearance.
- (d) A player coming from or returning from overseas, whether new to the club or returning to the club, must produce an International Clearance signed by the National Union from which he or she has come. The International Rugby Board (IRB) Clearance must be approved by NZRU.
- (e) A player shall not be eligible to play in any fixture unless the player or his / her club is in receipt of a signed copy of the International Clearance from the NZRU.
- (f) Transfers shall be considered for players transferring between Metropolitan clubs at a meeting of club representatives which shall be held within three weeks of the commencement of the competition. All clubs must submit their clearance forms at the commencement of this meeting. Should a club not be represented at this meeting, transfers requiring clearance from that club will automatically be granted. Any further action required to complete a transfer will be confirmed by the Convenor of the Metropolitan Transfers Subcommittee.
- (g) If a player has taken the field for one Metropolitan club and then wishes to transfer to another Metropolitan club within the first three weeks of the competition, the transfer clearance papers must be received by the ORFU by 1.00pm on the Thursday prior to the next game. The clearance application shall be considered by the Convenor of the Metropolitan Transfers Subcommittee. A decision will be given within 24 hours of the receipt of the application.

- (h) Where a transfer between Metropolitan clubs is requested after the third week of the commencement of the competition, application must be made to the Convenor of the Metropolitan Transfers Subcommittee. In such situations, each transfer application will be treated on individual merit and the player concerned will not be granted automatic transfer. The player seeking transfer will be subject to a 14 day stand down period starting from the time the application is received.
- (i) If a player is registered to a club in one Provincial Union and moves to a club in another Provincial Union in the same rugby season, then the new club or its Provincial Union must submit a transfer request to the NZRU.
- (j) If a player is registered to a club in one Provincial Union and moves to a club in another Provincial Union between rugby seasons, then the new club can register that player and no transfer request to the NZRU is required.
- (k) Any player not directly contracted to the ORFU (i.e. loan/ draft players) shall be allowed to play for the club to which they have been allocated.
- (l) Notwithstanding anything else contained in these rules, player transfers, including provincial transfers, shall not be granted within two weeks of semi-final or final matches in any competition.
- (m) If a team fields a player in breach of the transfer rules in Regulation 4 above, it shall forfeit any competition points (ladder and “for” and “against” differential) which it may have been awarded for the match in which that player has participated. A monetary fine of up to \$250 may also be imposed on the club at the discretion of the Metropolitan Rugby Council. The opposing team shall be awarded the maximum competition points for the match.

5. Registration and Team Registration Forms

- (a) All players must be registered with their club and registrations must be received by the ORFU on the appropriate NZRU registration forms as follows:
 - In respect of all Premier players prior to the first Premier competition game each year.
 - In respect of all other Senior grade players (including Womens and Colts) by the 1st of May each year.
 - In respect of all Junior players (Under 13 and below) and Secondary School players (Under 18 and below) by the 31st of May each year.
- (b) Any additional registrations which occur after the dates set out in 5 (a) above must be completed before the player takes the field for a game and received by the ORFU within 48 hours of the conclusion of that game.
- (c) Any team not fulfilling the requirements of Regulation 5a and/or 5b above shall forfeit all competition points gained in all games until the time that all players in that team are registered with the ORFU. Maximum competition points will be awarded to the opposition team(s) providing those teams have met the requirements of this and all other Metropolitan Regulations. In addition, clubs failing to furnish the NZRU player registration forms by the dates prescribed in 5a may be fined up to \$250.

6 Player Re-grades and Age Dispensations (Refer also to Regulation 8)

Note: For the purposes of this Rule, a “player” shall be a player named on the team sheet.

- (a) For approval to be given, all applications for re-grades and age dispensations must be received by the ORFU by 12 pm on the Thursday prior to a game. All applications will be considered by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.
- (b) A player may not play in a grade lower than his/her age qualifications, or if an open grade player, in any lower grade, unless a re-grading or age dispensation has been approved.
- (c) Any player who by virtue of age is eligible to play in an age regulated grade, but has played five or more games during the current season in a higher (or open) grade, shall not be eligible to play in the lower (eligible) grade unless a re-grading application has been approved.
- (d) Regular interchange of players between Premier grade Division 1 and Division 2 teams may be made without recourse to re-grading until the quarter-final, semi-final and final or promotion relegation games are played. For quarter final, semifinal and final or promotion relegation games, players named in Premier Division 2 teams may be named a maximum of seven times, on team sheets for Premier Division 1 teams during the season. In exceptional circumstances, dispensation may be given for players not meeting this requirement at the discretion of the Metropolitan Rugby Council.

- (e) A list of team squad player names for teams in quarter-finals, semi-finals, finals and promotion/relegation matches must be submitted for clearance and/or dispensation / re-grade approval to the ORFU at least five days prior to any promotion/relegation match. The total number of individual player appearances at a higher grade and/or division must be included on this team list. Exceptional circumstances will be considered on an individual basis and by application to the ORFU.
- (f) Age regulated grade players who play five or more games in a higher Division, shall not be eligible to play in a lower Division of the same grade within the same season unless a re-grading has been approved.
- (g) Any team not fulfilling the requirements of 6a, 6b, 6c and/or 6f will forfeit any competition points otherwise gained in all games until all players within that team are officially re-graded or granted dispensation by the Metropolitan Rugby Council. Maximum competition points will be awarded to the opposition team(s) providing those teams have met the requirements of this and all other Metropolitan regulations.

Guidelines to be used for Re-grades or Age Dispensations:

- (i) Number of dispensations approved for players in a particular team.
- (ii) Age / Height / Weight / Experience / Ability.
- (iii) Whether rugby is available at an appropriate grade if a request is declined or is borderline.
- (iv) COMMON SENSE.

The Metropolitan Rugby Council reserves the right to reconsider re-grades or dispensations if an approved re-graded or age dispensated player is having a significant effect on a team performance, or if the team numbers increase during the season.

7. Team Re-grading

Where a competition has commenced and approval is then given for a team to change to an alternative grade or to an alternative division of the same grade, then the following rules shall apply:

- (a) Where a team is removed from an even numbered competition, all flag points gained by opposing teams against that team will be forfeited and a bye shall ensue with no flag points awarded for the bye.
- (b) Where a team is removed from an odd numbered competition, all flag points gained by opposing teams against that team will be forfeited and the bye shall be removed.
- (c) Any team wishing to join an odd numbered competition may do so, but shall enter with no flag points, and all teams having had the bye shall be awarded five flag points.
- (d) Any team wishing to enter an even numbered competition may do so, but shall enter with no flag points.
- (e) Where possible, teams will be replaced or moved at the completion of a round.
- (f) The Metropolitan Rugby Council shall have discretion to approve the movement of teams.

8. Age Qualification

Players taking part in an age grade competition must be under the specified age as at the 1st of January preceding the start of the competition. For Colts Division 1 the age is under 21 years and for Junior Colts the age is under 20. The ORFU may require clubs to submit proof of age of players when making registration, or at any stage during the season.

- (a) A player may not play in any competition games in an age restricted grade if he or she is over the specified age, unless he or she has received dispensation to do so (see regulation 6 above).
- (b) A team may have a maximum of seven dispensated over-age players named on a team sheet, however only five dispensated over-age players from any one team may be on the field at any one time.
- (c) Any team breaching regulations 8a and/or 8b shall forfeit any competition points otherwise gained in all games until the regulations are met. Maximum competition points shall be awarded to the opposition team(s) providing they have met the requirements of Regulations 8(a) and 8(b) above and all other Metropolitan regulations.

9. Team numbers

- (a) A team shall not be allowed to take the field with fewer than 12 players, which shall include 3 players capable of playing in the front row. If a team is unable to field 12 players and/or 3 trained front row players at the appointed start time, the referee shall award the game to their opponents and record the reason on the result card.
- (b) In grades which have ORFU approval for non-contestable scrums, all teams finishing in the top four of that grade playing semi-finals and finals shall be required to play these games with contestable scrums under NZ Domestic Safety Law Variations and clause 9(a) shall apply.
- (c) Regulation 24 allows for larger squad numbers in certain grades.

10. Team Sheets

- (a) Each team shall complete a team sheet approved by the ORFU. The surname and initials (or first name) of each player and team officials must be provided on this sheet and **must be legible**.
- (b) The team sheet must indicate the designated front row replacements where applicable and contain names and numbers corresponding to the players in their respective positions.
- (c) The person signing the team sheet shall be the coach or manager and he or she shall bear the responsibility of ensuring that the information on the sheet is correct, and that it is submitted to the ORFU within the prescribed timeframe.
- (d) If team sheets are not supplied, or the information supplied does not meet the requirements of 10a and/or 10b, then the offending team or teams shall forfeit all competition points earned for that particular match. The opposition shall not receive these points. If both sides fail to comply with 10(a) (b) and (c) above, each side will record a loss.

11. Referee Performance Report

- (a) Any participating Premier Division 1 team playing in the Metropolitan competition has the opportunity to furnish a Referee Performance Report following a match.
- (b) The completed Referee Performance Report is to be returned to the ORFU's Referee Education Officer within 48 hours of the completion of the match.

12. Match Venue and Times

- (a) All club matches shall start at the time appointed by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.
- (b) Any teams not being on the appointed ground and ready to play at the appointed time shall be deemed to have defaulted the match, unless the Metropolitan Rugby Council in its discretion decides otherwise.
- (c) Requests for venue alterations or start times must be made in writing (email is acceptable) to the Metropolitan Rugby Council, The request must be signed by the Club Captain, Chairman or Secretary of the applying club, and contain evidence of agreement by the opposition team. The request must be received at least 14 days prior to the fixture due to be played.
- (d) In the case of requests for the deferment of games, notice in writing must be given to the Metropolitan Rugby Council by the club initiating the deferment request after consultation with opponents. The request for deferment must be signed by the club captains and the coaches of both clubs/schools and must include the date and time that the game is to be rescheduled. Failure to play the game on the rescheduled date will mean that the initiating team will be regarded as the defaulter and the provisions for defaults will apply. Where no mutual agreement can be reached, the game will stand as originally set by the Metropolitan Rugby Council .
- (e) The grounds on which any main home games are played must be roped off (or another suitable physical barrier used). Any deviation from this must be approved by the Metropolitan Ruby Council. Failure to comply with this regulation will result in the offending club's top team (the team entered in the highest grade in which the club competes) forfeiting its next home ground advantage with that game being played at the opposition's home ground or other venue, as decided by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.
- (f) Clubs must ensure grounds are adequately controlled, crowds are restrained by the provision of suitable barriers, and a ground official is appointed by the host club. In the absence of such a ground official, the manager of the home team shall assume this responsibility. When games are played on

neutral grounds, the host club and the Metropolitan Rugby Council shall take responsibility to ensure that the grounds are adequately controlled.

- (g) For all grounds that are roped off, there can be no more than three support personnel from each team inside the ropes at any time. All other team personnel, including coaching personnel and reserves, must be outside the roped area.

13. Defaults

- (a) Defaulting teams must notify the opposition Club Captain and the ORFU by 12 noon on the day before the match. Failure to observe that notification requirement will attract a fine of up to \$250. The non defaulting team shall be awarded the maximum competition points for the match and 20 points differential.
- (b) Should a team default two matches in succession, or three at intervals in any grade, it will be deemed to have withdrawn from the competition and any games it may have played shall not be counted in the competition.
- (c) Any team that defaults any game without 'good reason' (as determined by the Metropolitan Rugby Council) will forgo the right to their next home game, and will incur a fine of up to \$250.
- (d) The referee shall still submit a result card should one or both teams not be on the appointed ground ready to play at the appointed time. The ORFU shall submit a result card when prior advice has been provided.

14. Abandonment of Games

- (a) **Ground and Weather**
The referee of a match shall have the power to abandon the game if the condition of the ground or the weather conditions make it unsuitable for the game to be played. Before making any decision the referee shall take into account any request from the respective team captains for play to proceed.
- (b) **Conduct**
If a match is called off by the referee as a result of misconduct by players or team officials, the referee must report the matter in writing to the ORFU within 48 hours of the completion of the match. A decision will then be made as to whether the complaint will be dealt with by the Metropolitan Rugby Council, or ORFU, or if it should be referred to the Union's Complaints Review Officer. If referred to the Metropolitan Rugby Council, the team captain and the team manager or the team coach of the team(s) identified together with the referee shall appear before the next meeting of the Metropolitan Judicial Committee. The team(s) identified shall be suspended from playing until their officials appear before the Judicial Committee. After hearing from the team(s) identified and the referee, the Judicial Committee may decide:
 - (i) That no further action be taken.
 - (ii) That the team(s) or player(s) or team official(s) should be reprimanded.
 - (iii) That the team(s) or player(s) or team official(s) should be suspended for a period of time.

In any case, no flag points shall be awarded to a team proven to have caused abandonment.

15. Non Attendance of Referees

- (a) Should the appointed referee for any game fail to turn up for his or her appointed game, then the team or club must contact the referees' emergency phone number (021 0822 3466) to arrange a replacement referee.
- (b) Should there be no replacement referee available, then the game must not proceed.

16. Protests

- (a) Where a cause for a protest is known before a match, the opposing team and the referee shall be notified, and if the complaint is remedied then no further action shall be taken.
- (b) If the team protested against is unable or unwilling to remedy the reason for the protest, then the game shall be played "*under protest*" and an interim protest shall be recorded by the referee on the team sheets. A formal written protest must then be received by the ORFU within 48 hours of the completion of the match.

- (c) Where grounds for protest are discovered during or after the game, the protest must be made in writing to the ORFU within 48 hours of the completion of the match.
- (d) Protests must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$200. The fee will be refunded unless the protest is considered frivolous.

17. Complaints / Incidents

From time to time, incidents may occur at grounds before, during or following matches which result in a complaint being submitted which requires follow up action by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.

- (a) If a complaint (or citing) is made against a player, team, team official, referee or an identified supporter/spectator, it must be made in writing and submitted to the ORFU Community Rugby Manager within 48 hours of the completion of the match. A decision will then be made as to whether the complaint will be dealt with by the Metropolitan Rugby Council, or ORFU, or if it should be referred to the Union's Complaints Review Officer. If referred to the Metropolitan Rugby Council, the team captain and the team manager or the team coach of the team(s) identified together with the referee shall appear before the next meeting of the Metropolitan Judicial Committee. The team(s) identified shall be suspended from playing until their officials appear before the Judicial Committee. After hearing from the team(s) identified and the referee, the Judicial Committee may decide:
 - (i) That no further action be taken.
 - (ii) That the club(s) or team(s) or player(s) or team official(s) should be reprimanded.
 - (iii) That the club(s) or team(s) or player(s) or team official(s) should be suspended for a period of time.
- (b) Complaints must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$200. The fee will be refunded unless the complaint is considered frivolous.

18. Competition Points (All Grades)

Win	4 points
Draw	2 points
Loss	1 point if losing margin is 7 points or less.
Bonus Point	1 point if a team scores 4 tries or more.
Default	5 points and 20 points differential

Note: The team coach / manager will record the number of tries on the team sheet. The referee will also record the number of tries by each team on the result card.

19. Results

- (a) The result submitted by the referee via the referees result card and signed by a team official from each team shall be the official result.
- (b) If team officials are not available to sign the result card, then the result submitted by the referee stands.
- (c) Result cards must be in the hands of the ORFU Office by **9.00am on the Tuesday following the fixture.**

20. Semi-Finals and Finals Format

In the event that two or more teams in any grade finish the round-robin with the same number of flag points, the finishing positions will be determined in accordance with the following criteria which shall be applied in the sequence in which they appear below until a result as to the positions of the teams is determined:

- (a) Where any two teams are tied, the team with the higher number of flag points in games between the two shall have the higher position.
- (b) Where three or more teams are tied, teams will be ranked in order, with the team with the higher number of flag points in games between the teams shall have the higher position.
- (c) Where teams are still tied the teams with the higher points differential following the round-robin matches, shall have the higher position.
- (d) If after application of 20c, teams still remain tied, the team with the most wins in the round-robin, shall have the higher position.

- (e) In the event the teams are still tied, the team with the most tries following the round-robin matches shall have the higher position.
- (f) By the toss of a coin. The winner of the toss shall take the higher position.

In the event that teams are tied at the end of a quarter-final or semi-final, the winner shall be determined by the following criteria, which shall be applied in sequence in which they appear below until a result is determined:

- (i) Following a break of five minutes, the toss shall be made again.
- (ii) A further 10 minutes of extra time each way shall be played.
- (iii) The team which has scored the most tries in the match.
- (iv) The highest ranked qualifying team for semi-final.

In the event that teams are tied at the end of a final, the winner shall be determined by the following criteria, which shall be applied in sequence in which they appear below until a result is determined:

- (i) Following a break of five minutes, the toss shall be made again.
- (ii) A further 10 minutes of extra time each way shall be played.
- (iii) The team which has scored the most tries in the match.
- (iv) The teams will be declared joint winners.

Note: All major trophies in the round-robin can be shared.

21. Promotion Relegation

- (a) Promotion relegation games shall only be played between Premier Division 1 and Premier Division 2 grades. In all grades including Premier Division 2 and below clubs may enter teams at their discretion.
- (b) Should the winner of the Premier 2 Division competition choose to seek promotion to play in the Premier Division 1 competition the following season that team may challenge the bottom placed team in the Premier Division 1 Grade to a promotion relegation game.
- (c) The promotion relegation game shall be played after both teams have completed play in their respective competitions. The date and time of the game shall be set by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.
- (d) The game shall be played at a neutral venue to be decided by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.
- (e) For the promotion relegation game the conditions set out in Regulation 6(d) shall apply.
- (f) The winner of the promotion relegation game will play in the Premier Division 1 competition the following season.
- (g) In unusual or exceptional circumstances (e.g. the winning club in the promotion relegation game is unable to field a team in the Premier Division 1 competition the following or subsequent years) the situation will be addressed by the Metropolitan Rugby Council.
- (h) In the event that the teams are tied at the end of a promotion relegation game, the game shall be declared a draw and there shall be no promotion relegation for the ensuing season.
- (i) Only Premier Division 2 teams (clubs) not represented in Premier Division 1 can play in promotion relegation games.

22. Compulsory Safety Courses

Coaches of all teams and all referees **MUST** be Rugby Smart accredited on an annual basis in accordance with current NZRU requirements and accredited prior to the commencement of the rugby season.

23. Referee Abuse

For serious incidents of referee abuse – verbal, physical, other – by a team, player(s), club/team official(s) or identified club/team supporter(s) prior to, during or following a fixture reported by the referee, reports (on NZRU Referee Abuse Incident Report form) must be received by the ORFU Community Rugby Manager within 48 hours of the completion of the fixture. The Union's Complaints Review Officer will determine if the incident(s) should be heard by the Metropolitan Judicial Committee. If so, the players(s), official(s) or in the case of an identified

supporter(s), an appropriate club official, shall appear before the next meeting of the Judicial Committee. After hearing the matter(s) the Judicial Committee may decide:

- (i) That no further action be taken.
- (ii) That the person(s) responsible should be reprimanded for their conduct.
- (iii) That the person(s) responsible should be suspended for a period appropriate to the offence.
- (iv) That no flag points gained from the fixture shall be awarded to the team concerned.

Note: It shall be mandatory for the person(s) concerned to submit a written apology to the referee.

24. Modified Replacement / Substitution Laws

(a) Premier Division 1 - Premier Division 2 - Colts Division 1 - Highlanders Secondary Schools Division:

- (i) Teams are to adhere to the current Law including Domestic Safety Law Variations without modification.

(b) Women's Division 1 – Secondary School Under 18 Divisions (excluding Highlanders Secondary Schools Division):

- (i) Teams may have a maximum of 22 players but shall have a minimum of 5 front row players for squads of 22, and a minimum of 4 front row players for squads of 21. For squads of 20 players or less there shall be a minimum of 3 front row players.
- (ii) No distinction is made between substitutions and replacements.
- (iii) At around the halfway stage of both halves when a convenient stoppage occurs, and also at half time, the referee will allow substitutions to take place. Up to seven players can be substituted at each of these times. Players who have been substituted may return to the field of play as a substitute player or as a replacement for an injured player from any position.
- (iv) Substitutions cannot be made at other times during a game.
- (v) Normal injury replacements are allowed. Injured players with a non blood injury who have been replaced may not return and play in that game.

(c) Senior Grade – Women's Divisions (other than Division 1) Colts Divisions (other than Division 1) - Youth Grades – Secondary School Grades (other than Under 18):

- (i) Teams may have a maximum of 26 players which must include 5 front row players for squads of 22 to 26, 4 front row players for squads of 21, and 3 front row players for squads of 20 or less. Rule 24b above applies for player replacements/substitutions except that the number of substitute player movements during each of the 3 periods shall be increased to up to 9.

- (d) **All competition grades: Quarter-finals, Semi-finals and Finals - full current Laws apply.**

25. Trophies

The winning clubs in all grades or sections shall hold the trophies allocated for such competitions. The trophies shall be returned to the ORFU office no later than 30th June of the following season.

Disciplinary Procedures

PROCEDURES THAT APPLY WHEN A PLAYER IS ORDERED OFF:

Metropolitan Club Players:

The Otago Rugby Football Union has adopted Rule 17 'Alternative Two week suspension procedure' of the NZRU Disciplinary "Black Book" Rule 18 – Notice to Player also applies.

RULE 17 – 'ALTERNATIVE TWO WEEK SUSPENSION PROCEDURE'

- (a) A Player ordered off is automatically suspended and not permitted to play any game of rugby for the period of two weeks (this equates to two matches) from the date of his ordering off;
- (b) If within 48 hours of the Ordering Off, the Player Ordered Off, personally or through his Club notifies the Union that he requests a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee the Union shall within six days of the Ordering Off convene a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee;
- (c) If within seven days of having received copies of the reports of Match Officials on the Ordering Off, which the Union will obtain and provide to the Player personally or through his Club forthwith, the Player Ordered Off notifies the Union that he requests a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee the Union shall within six days of such notification convene a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee;
- (d) After having received copies of the reports of the Match Officials on the Ordering Off a nominated member of the Union Judicial Panel or the Union Complaints Review Officer shall perform an assessment of whether the two-week suspension of the Player is an adequate sanction taking into account the requirements of Rule 70 of the NZRU Disciplinary Rule or whether the matter should proceed to a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee. In the event that the nominated member of the Judicial Panel or the Union Complaints Review Officer determines that the two week suspension is not an adequate sanction in the circumstances then he should refer the matter to hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee;
- (e) If a player requests, or the nominated member of the Judicial Panel or the Union Complaints Review Officer determines that the matter should proceed to a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee, the Union should revert to a normal process for Players Ordered Off with the notice to be provided to the Player Under Rule 18 of the NZRU Disciplinary Rule:
- (f) IN fixing any period of suspension under Sections 4 and 9 the Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee shall take into account of any period of suspension already served by the Player by operation of this Rule.

RULE 18 - NOTICE TO PLAYER

In the event that a matter is to proceed to a hearing before a Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee, the Player Ordered Off shall be supplied with a copy of the Referee's Report and, where applicable, the Touch Judge's Report by the Community Rugby Manager of the Union and advised:

- (a) Of the date, place and time of the Hearing of the Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee;
- (b) That the Player will be required to attend the hearing;
- (c) That if the Player is unable to appear at the hearing the Player should personally or through his Club should advise the Community Rugby Manager forthwith;
- (d) That the Player is entitled to adduce evidence and make submissions and be represented by his Club and / or legal advisor; and
- (e) The Player is not eligible to play pending resolution of the case

Where possible notice of the Ordered Off Player under this Rule shall be given in writing. It shall be sufficient compliance with this Rule if a copy of the Referee's Report and, where applicable, the Touch Judge's report and the information required to be given by this Rule is sent to the Ordered Off Player's address last known to the Community Rugby Manager of the Union or are handed to the Player or are sent to the Secretary of the Player's Club.

Metropolitan Secondary School Players:

- The disciplinary hearing will be held at the player's school. The Rugby Administrator in Schools or the team coach is notified in writing including a copy of the referee report, (fax) and is requested to contact the Chairman of the Metropolitan Judicial Committee to arrange for the hearing to proceed as soon as possible.
- The Judicial Chairman (or his representative) will convene the hearing with 1 or 2 representatives from the school, he has the same powers as a full Committee in reaching a decision in accordance with the NZRU Rules for Disciplinary Hearings.

Note: Players who have been ordered off are unable to play again at any location, or at any time, until they have attended a hearing.

Appeal Rights:

- Either party has the right to appeal the decision.
- An appeal must be lodged with ORFU within 7 days of the decision being notified, and must be accompanied with a deposit of up to \$500 + GST. (amount will be advised on notification of appeal)
- The ORFU Appeal Committee will then convene as soon as practicable (usually on a Wednesday) to hear the matter.
- An appeal hearing is a re-hearing so all parties should attend as evidence will be reheard.
- Additional written evidence may be submitted, and should be received by ORFU within 48 hours of the scheduled Appeal Hearing. The Appeal Committee has full discretionary powers to receive and hear such evidence.
- The Appeal Committee will deliberate and (usually) provide a verbal decision plus reasons immediately following the hearing.
- Written notification of the decision will be sent to the player's Club as soon as it is available.

Procedures that apply when lodging a complaint (or citing):

- Any person may submit a complaint.
- Must be submitted in writing and received by ORFU within 48 hours of the fixture or incident, preferably on ORFU Incident Report or Referee Abuse Report form. Note: this timing is critical under NZRU Rules for further action to be instituted.
- ORFU Complaints Review Officer reviews and determines if the complaint shall proceed to a hearing before the Judicial Committee.
- Judicial Committee set a date and time for the hearing.
- Notification and procedures then follow the same sequence as described above for an ordering off.

Regulations For Country Club Rugby

A separate set of rules for the 2011 Countrywide Competition will be released separately, all Country Clubs will be notified in due course.

1. CONTROL

- a) All matches including non-competition games shall be under the control of the Country Board and all entries shall be subject to its approval. The Country Board shall classify the various clubs, teams and players, arrange dates, times and venues for matches in the various grades, and deal with all questions arising out of the same.
- b) Notwithstanding anything else contained within these rules, the Country Board shall retain the right to amend any competition and/or challenge cup rules should the circumstances so dictate.

2. TRANSFERS

- a) If a player is registered to a club and moves to another club within the same Provincial Union, either in the same rugby season or between rugby seasons, that player must comply with the club transfer policy in that Provincial Union.
- b) All players (including secondary school players playing for a club) wishing to transfer to another club must obtain a written clearance from the club whom they last played for in the previous 12 months. That clearance must state that the former club has consented to that transfer, that the player is not subject to any suspension or playing ban and that the transferring player is not in arrears with his subscription.
- c) Notwithstanding Rule 2(b) above, a player who has not played rugby in the previous 12 months shall not be required to provide a clearance.
- d) A player coming from or returning from overseas, whether new to the club or returning to the club, must produce an International Clearance signed by the National Union from which he has come. The International Clearance must be approved by the NZRU.
- e) Where a player has taken the field for one Country Club and then wishes to transfer to another Country Club after the start of the club rugby season, then that player must submit the transfer clearance papers to the Country Rugby Co-ordinator by 12pm on the Thursday prior to the next game and have his transfer application approved prior to the transferring player playing for his new club.
- f) Notwithstanding anything else contained in these rules, player transfers including provincial transfers, shall not be granted within two weeks of semi-final or final matches in any competition.
- g) If a player is registered to a club in one Provincial Union and moves to a club in another Provincial Union in the same rugby season, then the new club or its Provincial Union must submit a transfer request to the NZRU.
- h) If a player is registered to a club in one Provincial Union and moves to a club in another Provincial Union between rugby seasons, then the new club can register that player and no transfer request to the NZRU is required.
- i) If a team fields a player in breach of the transfer rules in Regulation 2 above, it shall forfeit any competition points (ladder, and *“for and against”* differential) which it may have been awarded for the match in which that player has participated. A monetary fine of up to \$250 may also be imposed on the club at the discretion of the Country Board. The opposing team shall be awarded the maximum competition points for the match.

In the event the particular match involved a challenge cup entitlement, the offending team shall forfeit the cup and the opposing team shall be awarded the cup.

- j) Applications for a dispensation from any provisions of Regulation 2 above must be made in writing to the Country Rugby Co-ordinator. The affected player is not permitted to play for his new club prior to the new Club receiving the written approval of the Country Board via the Country Rugby Co-ordinator.

3. REGISTRATION

- a) All players must be registered to their club and registrations must be received by the ORFU on the appropriate NZRU registration forms prior to the first competition game each year (**in 2011 - before 2 April**).
- b) Any additional registrations which occur after the date set out in 3(a) above must be completed before the player takes the field for a game and received by the ORFU within 48 hours of the conclusion of that game.
- c) Any club playing an unregistered player shall forfeit any competition points (ladder, and “for and against” differential), which it may have been awarded for the match in which that player has participated. The opposing team shall be awarded the maximum competition points for the match. In the event the particular match involved a challenge cup entitlement, the offending team shall forfeit the cup and the opposing team shall be awarded the cup.
- d) All club teams must submit to the Country Rugby Co-ordinator prior to Wednesday 30 March 2011 a team registration form that records the first name, surname, date of birth, address and telephone numbers of all players, coaches, managers, and sports medics.

4. TEAM SHEETS

- a) Prior to the commencement of any game, each team must submit a team sheet to the referee on a form approved by the Country Board. The surname and initials (or first name) of each player must be provided on this sheet and must be legible.
- b) The team sheet must indicate the designated front row replacements where applicable and contain names and numbers corresponding to the players in their respective positions.
- c) The person signing the team sheet shall be the coach or manager and he shall bear the responsibility of ensuring that the information on the sheet is correct, and that it is submitted to the referee for his/her signature.
- d) If team sheets are not supplied, then the offending team or teams shall forfeit all competition points earned for the particular match. The opposition team shall not receive these points. If both sides fail to supply team sheets, each side will record a loss.
- e) At the end of the match, the referee shall record the score (including the number of tries scored by each team) and after signing the team sheets, shall return the sheets to the respective team Managers/Coaches to counter-sign. The Managers/Coaches shall be responsible to forwarding the completed team sheets to the Country Rugby Co-ordinator by 12pm on the first working day following the fixture.

5. PROTESTS

- a) Where a cause for a protest is known before a match, the opposing team and the referee should be notified, and if the complaint is remedied then no further action will be taken.
- b) If the team protested against is unable or unwilling to remedy the reason for the protest, then the game shall be played “*under protest*” and the referee shall record the interim protest on the team sheets. The Country Rugby Co-ordinator must then receive a formal written protest within 48 hours of the completion of the match.
- c) Where grounds for protest are discovered during or after the game, the protest must be made in writing to the Country Rugby Co-ordinator within 48 hours of the completion of the match.
- d) Protests must be made in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$250. The fee will be refunded unless the protest is considered frivolous

6. MATCH VENUE & TIMES

- a) All games are to commence at 3pm unless otherwise determined by the Country Board or unless otherwise agreed upon by both teams (Central Region Club Premier fixtures are to start at 2.45pm)
- b) All matches postponed on the Saturday due to weather and/or road conditions are to be played on the Sunday. If neither day is suitable, the matches are to be played at a date set by the Country Board (or by its Emergency Committee). Where possible, if grounds are unplayable, a member of the Emergency Committee must be notified by 7pm the night before the game.
- c) Clubs must ensure grounds are adequately controlled, crowds are restrained by the provision of suitable barriers, and the host club appoints a ground official. In the absence of such a ground official, the manager of the home team shall assume this responsibility. When games are played on neutral grounds, the host club shall take responsibility to ensure that the grounds are adequately controlled.
- d) For all grounds that are roped off, there can be no more than three support personnel from each team inside the ropes at any time. All other team personnel, including coaching personnel and reserves, must be outside the roped area.

7. DEFAULTS

- a) Defaulting teams must notify the opposition Club Captain and the Country Rugby Co-ordinator by 12pm on the day before the match. Failure to observe that notification requirement will attract a fine of **\$500** payable to the Country Board by the following Friday. The non-defaulting team shall be awarded the maximum competition points for the match and 20 points differential. In the event the particular match involved a challenge cup entitlement, the offending team shall forfeit the cup and the opposing team shall be awarded the cup.

8. COMPETITION FORMAT

- a) Local Premier Competitions are to be determined by the Country Board after advice from the Central and Southern Councils of Clubs respectively but shall not be in conflict with any of the Rules herein.

- b) **Competition Points** (Premier and 2nd Grades)

Win	4 points
Draw	2 points
Loss	1 point if losing margin is 7 points or less
Bonus	1 point if a team scores 4 tries or more

- If teams are tied on the same number of competition points, the team that won the game between the two sides shall take the higher place.
- If all are still equal, the team with the most bonus points shall take the higher place.
- If still equal, point's differential shall decide which team takes the higher position.

- c) **Semi-Finals and Finals Format**

Top 4: 1 plays 4 and 2 plays 3, then winners to final

If teams are tied at full-time, then following is to apply:

- Five minute break – toss made again – 5 minutes each way

If scores still tied:

- Toss again – team that scores first will be declared the winner. Teams change ends every 5 minutes.

Two highest qualifiers get home semi-finals. Finals are to be played at highest qualifier's venue.

9. JUDICIAL HEARINGS

All judicial matters shall be carried out in accordance with the NZRU Disciplinary Rules and procedures (Black Book). It will be normal practice for players and officials to be heard by an appropriate Judicial Officer or Judicial Committee. Any policy that involves a stand-down period and no judicial hearing will be advised to clubs.

10. GENERAL

- (a) The Country Board will address any matter not contained within the rules separately on its merits; this includes but is not limited to the temporary playing in Country competitions by professional rugby players contracted to the NZ Rugby Union.
- (b) Any decisions taken by the Country Board are subject to an appeal to the ORFU. Any appeal must be lodged within seven days of the receipt of the Country Board's decision and must be accompanied by an appeal fee of \$500 plus GST.

11. COMPULSORY SAFETY COURSES

Coaches of all teams and all referees **MUST** be Rugby Smart accredited on an annual basis in accordance with current NZRU requirements and accredited prior to the commencement of the rugby season.

12. REFEREE ABUSE

For serious incidents of referee abuse – verbal, physical, other – by a team, player(s), club/team official(s) or identified club/team supporter(s) prior to, during or following a fixture reported by the referee, reports (on NZRU Referee Abuse Incident Report form) must be received by the ORFU Amateur Rugby Operations Co-ordinator within 48 hours of the completion of the fixture. The Union's Complaints Review Officer will determine if the Disciplinary Committee should hear the incident(s). If so, the player(s), official(s) or in the case of an identified supporter(s), an appropriate club official, shall appear before the next meeting of the Disciplinary Committee. After hearing the matter(s) the Disciplinary Committee may decide:

- (i) That no further action be taken.
- (ii) That the person(s) responsible should be reprimanded for their conduct.
- (iii) That the person(s) responsible should be suspended for a period appropriate to the offence.
- (iv) That no flag points gained from the fixture shall be awarded to the team concerned.

13. ABANDONMENT OF GAMES

a) Ground and Weather

The referee of a match shall have the power to abandon the game if the condition of the ground or the weather conditions make it unsuitable for the game to be played. Before making any decision the referee shall take into account any request from the respective team captains for play to proceed.

b) Conduct

If the referee as a result of misconduct by players or team officials calls off a match, the referee must report the matter in writing to the ORFU within 48 hours of the completion of the match. A decision will then be made as to whether the Country Board, or ORFU will deal with the complaint, or if it should be referred to the Union's Complaints Review Officer. If referred to the Country Board, the team captain and the team manager or the team coach of the team(s) identified together with the referee shall appear before the next meeting of the Country Disciplinary Committee. The team(s) identified shall be suspended from playing until their officials appear before the Disciplinary Committee. After hearing from the team(s) identified and the referee, the Disciplinary Committee may decide:

- (i) That no further action be taken.
- (ii) That the team(s) or player(s) or team official(s) should be reprimanded.
- (iii) That the team(s) or player(s) or team official(s) should be suspended for a period of time.

In any case, no flag points shall be awarded to a team proven to have caused abandonment.

14. REREREE PERFORMANCE REPORT

- (a) Any participating Premier team playing in the Country competition has the opportunity to furnish a Referee Performance Report following a match.
- (b) The completed Referee Performance Report is to be returned to the ORFU's Referee Education Officer within 48 hours of the completion of the match.

Rugby Injuries

Sports Medicine Otago-Southland

THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES ARE RECOMMENDED IN THE EVENT OF INJURIES:

Injuries at Training

If an injury is sustained at training, and if the club or team physiotherapist, doctor or sports medic are present, they should also be consulted immediately. If no medical personnel are available, consult the team manager. If there is any doubt about the seriousness of an injury, an ambulance should be requested to attend. If considered suitable, the injured player may be taken to the Dunedin Sports Injury Clinic if it is open. Please see below and check the club notice for details the times the clinic is open.

Pre-Game Preparation - Pre-Game Strapping Service

This service is available from the Dunedin Sports Injury Clinic between 9.00am and 1.00pm each Saturday. A charge relative to the materials required is made when clinic tape is used. No charge is made if you or your team or club provide suitable tape. It is recommended that a pre-game strapping be applied 1 to 2 hours prior to the commencement of the game.

Playing Days - Treatment of Injuries

On advice from your team medical personnel, team management or other medical personnel, injuries should be directed to the Sports Injury Clinic, the address and location of which is shown below. X-Ray facilities are not available but staff can easily refer to these services when required. Doctors with postgraduate qualifications in Sports Medicine staff the clinic and are assisted by other Sports Medicine personnel. A physiotherapist is also available.

The clinic is operated by Sports Medicine Otago-Southland for the benefit of all injured sports people.

No charge is made for the treatment of injuries at either clinic.

The clinic is dedicated to assisting where they can with the Otago District Health Board drive to "KEEP THE EMERGENCY DEPARTMENT FOR EMERGENCIES". Where at all possible, sports injuries should be directed to the clinic first. Similarly, if any player has any doubt as to the severity of an injury, it should be assessed on the Saturday or the Sunday after the game. Clinic staff can refer to the appropriate professionals if further assistance is required with an injury.

DO YOU HAVE A SPORTS MEDIC WITH YOUR TEAM?

Sports Medicine Otago-Southland conducts instructional courses as part of the Sports Medicine Accreditation Scheme. These courses include:

- Sports Medic Course This course is designed for people who are associated with and support a team on a regular basis.
- Sports Massage Course This course is aimed to compliment the Sports Medic Course but no pre-requisite qualifications are required to attend this.

Please contact the Clinic Co-ordinator (address and contact information are shown above) for more details. All courses are oriented toward sports related injuries.

Courses are normally held early each year but additional courses can be arranged for groups if numbers warrant this.
